The period before the First Kingdom was known as the Early Dynastic Period. In that time, during the First Dynasty, Egypt became one country. However, it was not until the Third Dynasty during the Old Kingdom period, under the rule of the Pharaoh Djoser, that Egypt's government became strong and powerful. Government and religion were connected in Ancient Egypt and the pharaoh was the head of both. The pharaoh was like a king and was the most powerful person in Ancient Egypt, thought to be connected to the gods. The vizier worked under the pharaoh and completed most of the government's daily work. The first vizier was Imhotep. Viziers were highly educated with skills of an accountant, architect, lawyer, judge, farmer, and priest.
