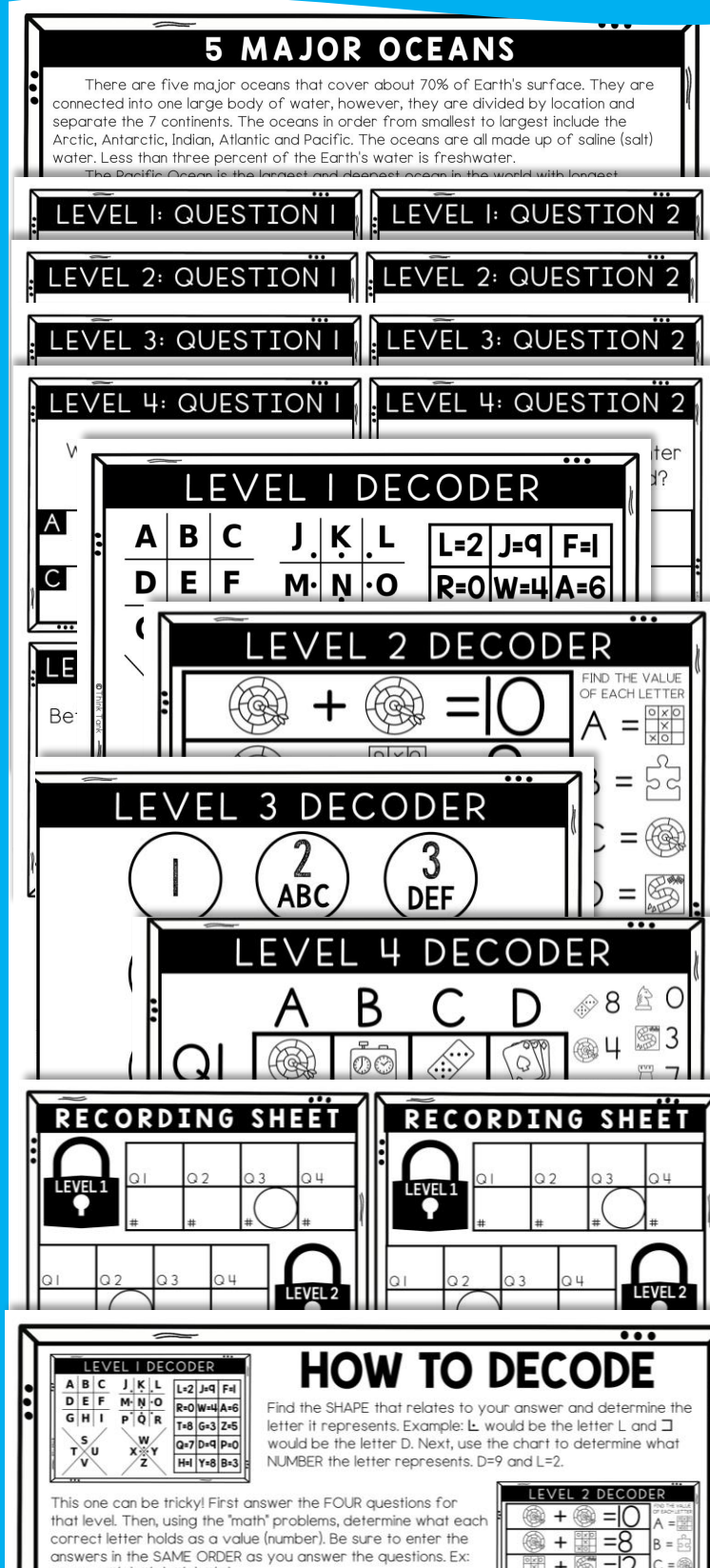

Oceans that cover about 70% of Earth's surface. The oceans in order from smallest to largest are the Arctic, Indian, Atlantic, and Pacific. The oceans are salty. About 97 percent of the Earth's water is fresh water. The largest and deepest ocean in the world is the Pacific Ocean, which is located between Australia and Asia to the west and the North Pacific and South Pacific to the east. The Mariana Trench is the deepest part of the ocean, located in the western Pacific. It is about 12,467 feet deep.

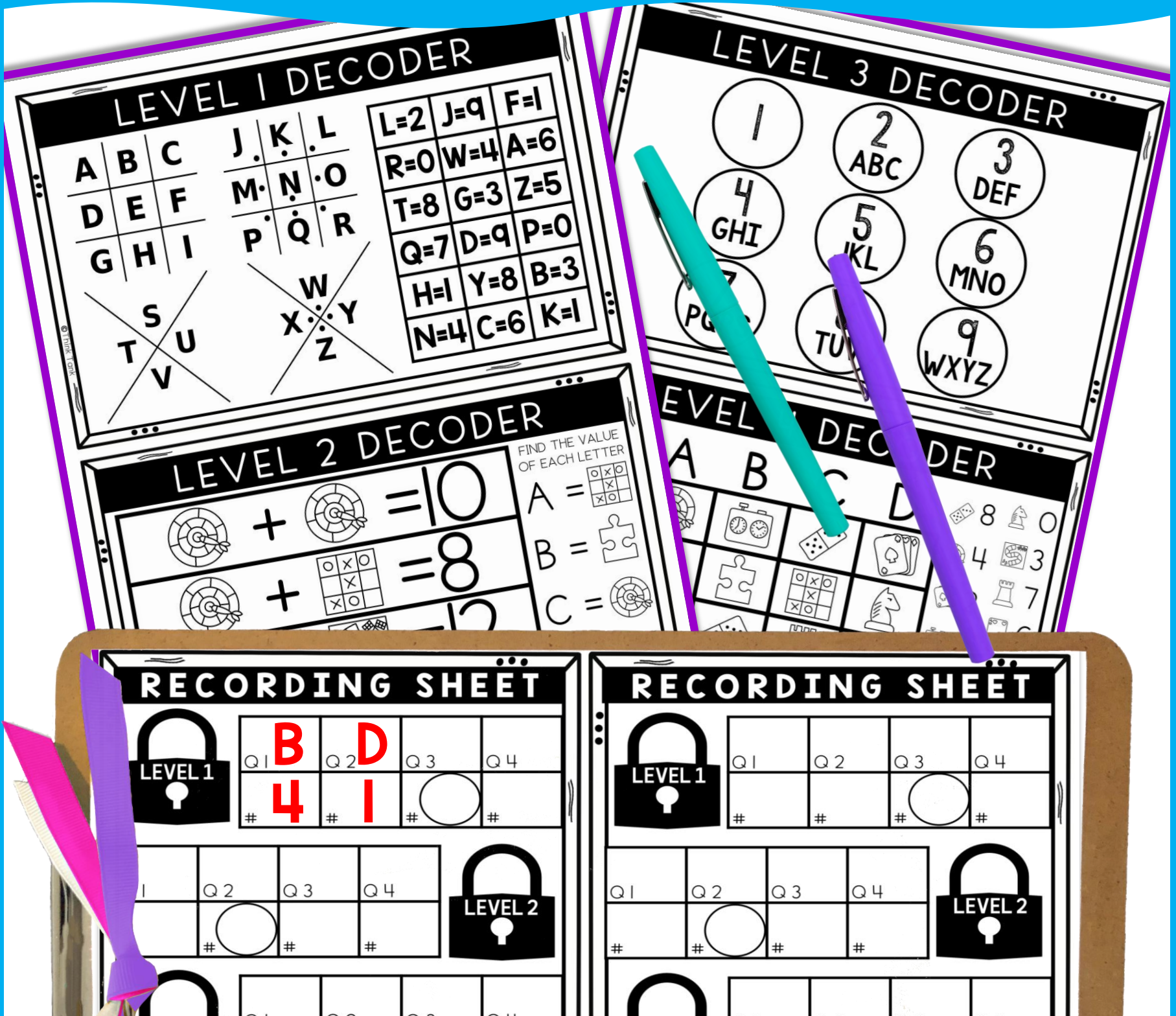

5 MAJOR OCEANS

There are five major oceans that cover about 70% of the Earth's surface. They are connected into one large body of water, however, they are separated by landmasses that separate the 7 continents. The oceans in order from smallest to largest are the Arctic, Antarctic, Indian, Atlantic and Pacific. The oceans cover about 70% of the Earth's water. Less than three percent of the Earth's water is freshwater. The Pacific Ocean is the largest and deepest ocean on Earth. It is located between Australia and Asia to the west and the Americas to the east.

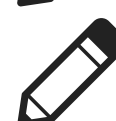
