




In 221 BC, Qin Shi Huangdi of the Qin dynasty brought all of China under one rule as the first emperor of the unified Chinese Empire. Qin Shi was a harsh emperor, but also contributed to many advancements during his brief time in power. He began building the Great Wall of China, created a writing system, and built rows and canals that made travel and trade easier. He was buried with a Terracotta Army.
