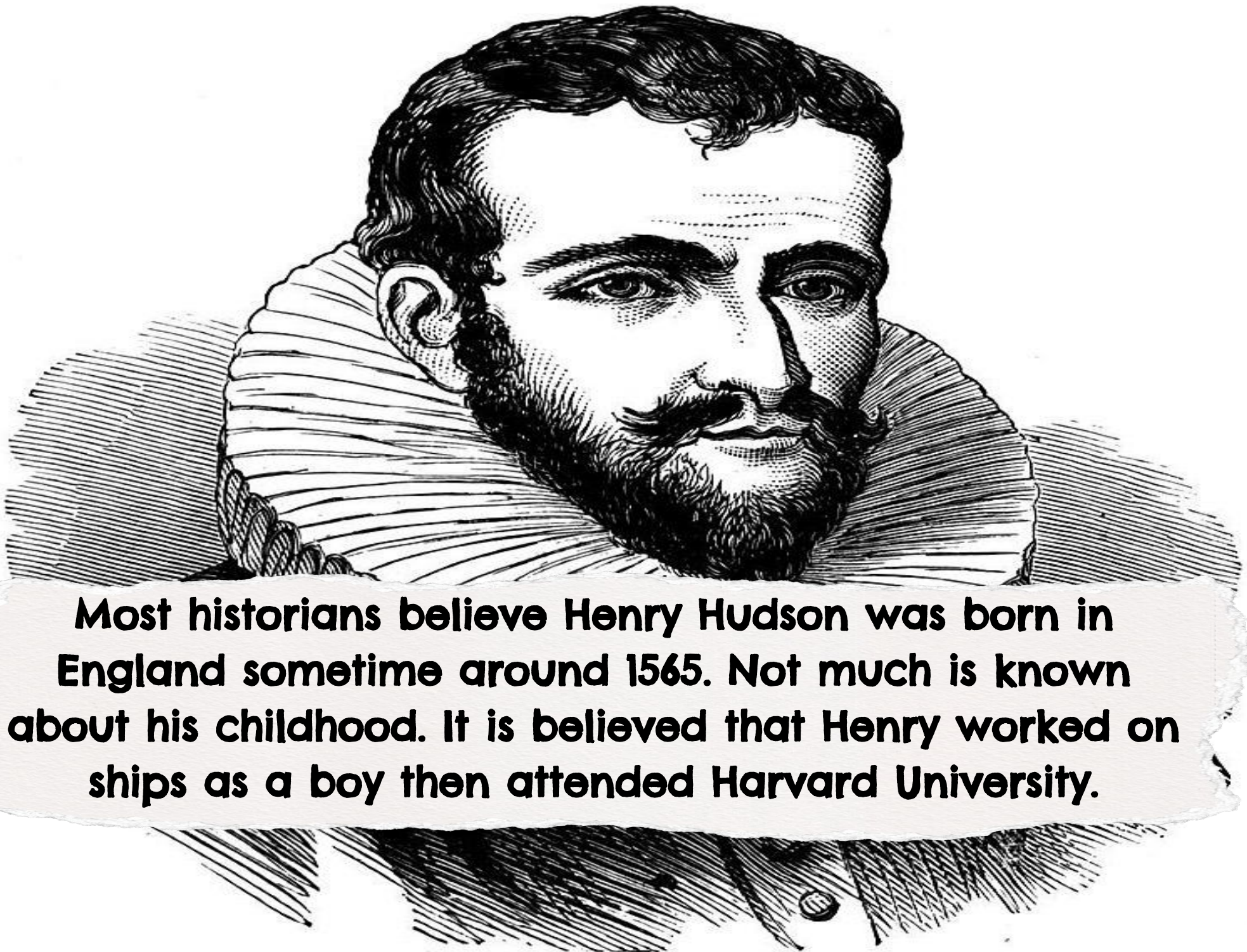

Return of Ship in 1611 - - - - -*


