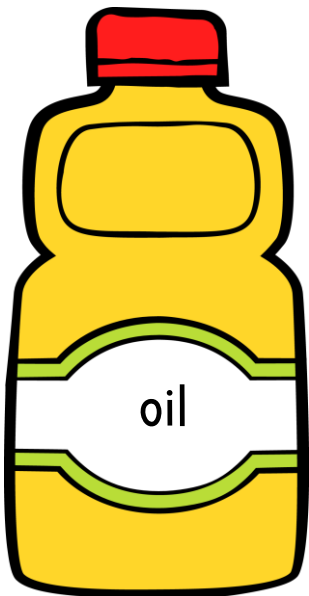

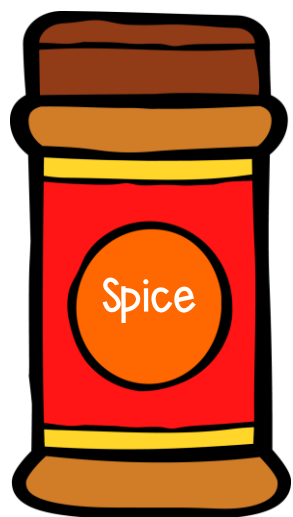

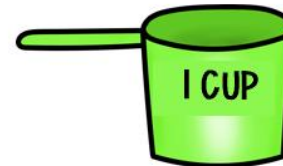
Leif Erikson, son of Erik the Red, was the Viking who landed in Canada. He arrived in North America 500 years before Christopher Columbus.
