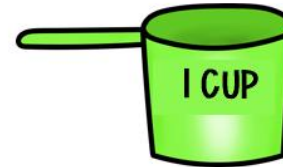


SUGAR

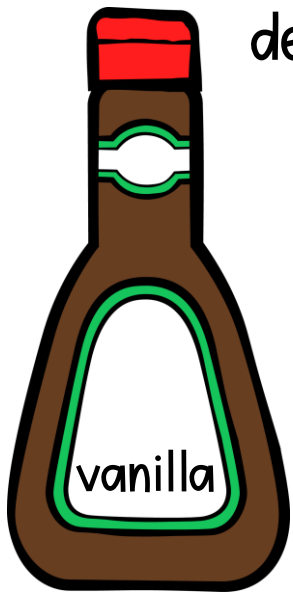

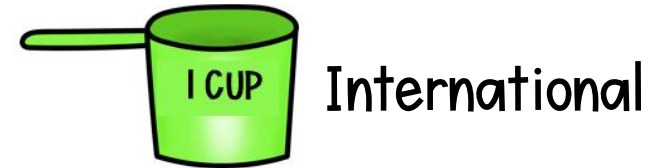

The U.S. Constitution grants specific powers to the national government. The word Constitution simply means plan of government. These powers are referred to as expressed, delegated or enumerated powers. The federal (national) government can negotiate treaties, provide defense and create foreign policies with other countries.

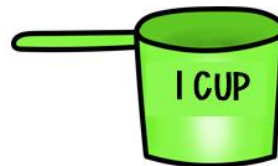

Reserved powers are reserved specifically for the states. Each individual state has the power to pass, enforce and interpret laws, as long as they do not violate the Constitution. Concurrent powers are powers that are shared by both the federal and state governments, such

as collecting taxes and maintaining roads. The United States, Mexico, and Canada operate under federal systems.
