


Before 1764, the British government allowed the 13 colonies to govern themselves. As time went on, Brita continued imposing new taxes and laws on the colonist. There were many taxes collected through British law such as the Sugar Act and Stamp Act. The Stamp Aplaced a tax on all printed goods, like newspapers playing cards. The colonists did not believe an

Tensions rose as the British government started to become more involved with the l3 colonies. Protests erupted as the colonists became more and more angry. A group of Patriots in Boston, who called themselves the Sons of Liberty, started protesting the taxes and laws. The protests led to violence in 1770 when the British soldiers fired into a crowd of colonists, killing five men. This event became known as the Boston Massacre.






