Tensions rose as the British government started to become more involved with the 13 colonies. Protests erupted as the colonists became more and more angry. A group of Patriots in Boston, who called themselves the Sons of Liberty, started protesting the taxes and laws. The protests led to violence in 1770 when the British soldiers fired into a crowd of colonists, killing five men. This event became known as the Boston Massacre.


