The period of time in Ancient Egypt from 1520 BC to 1075 BC is divided into three main kingdoms at different time periods: the Old Kingdom, the Middle Kingdom, and the New Kingdom, also known as the Late Period. The New Kingdom, also known as the Late Period, was the most prosperous (successful) and powerful one of the three. It was located along the Nile River in northeast Africa. The New Kingdom was a time of great achievements throughout this period; the Eighteenth, the Nineteenth, and the Twentieth Dynasties are the most famous. The most famous pharaohs of the New Kingdom are the Thutmose III, Hatshepsut, and Tutankhamun (known as the Boy King).
