

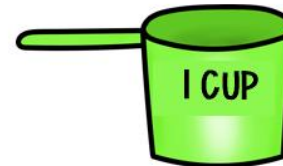
CAKE MIX

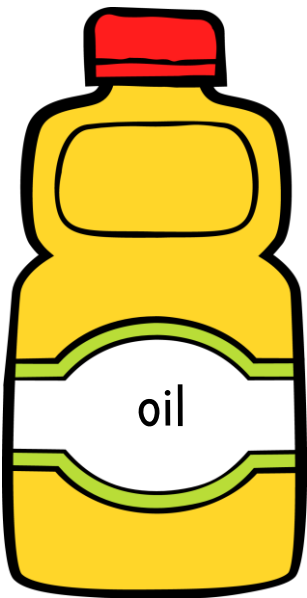

SUGAR

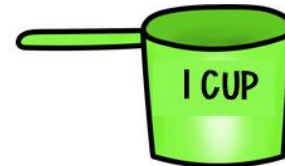
