The Seven Years' War, fought in Europe, involved major global powers, including Britain, France, Austria, and Prussia. The French and Indian War (1756-1763) was between Britain and France as well but spread to North America for control of that land. It is considered to be a part of the Seven Years' War, although the fighting in North America is known as the French and Indian War.

When France expanded into the Ohio River area, Britain declared war. The war was actually fought between the French and the British, both having Native American allies. An alliance is a union formed that agrees to work together for a mutual benefit. The French allied with the Shawnee, Lenape, Qjibwa, Ottawa, and the Algonquin. The British allied with the Iroquois, Catawba, and Cher
