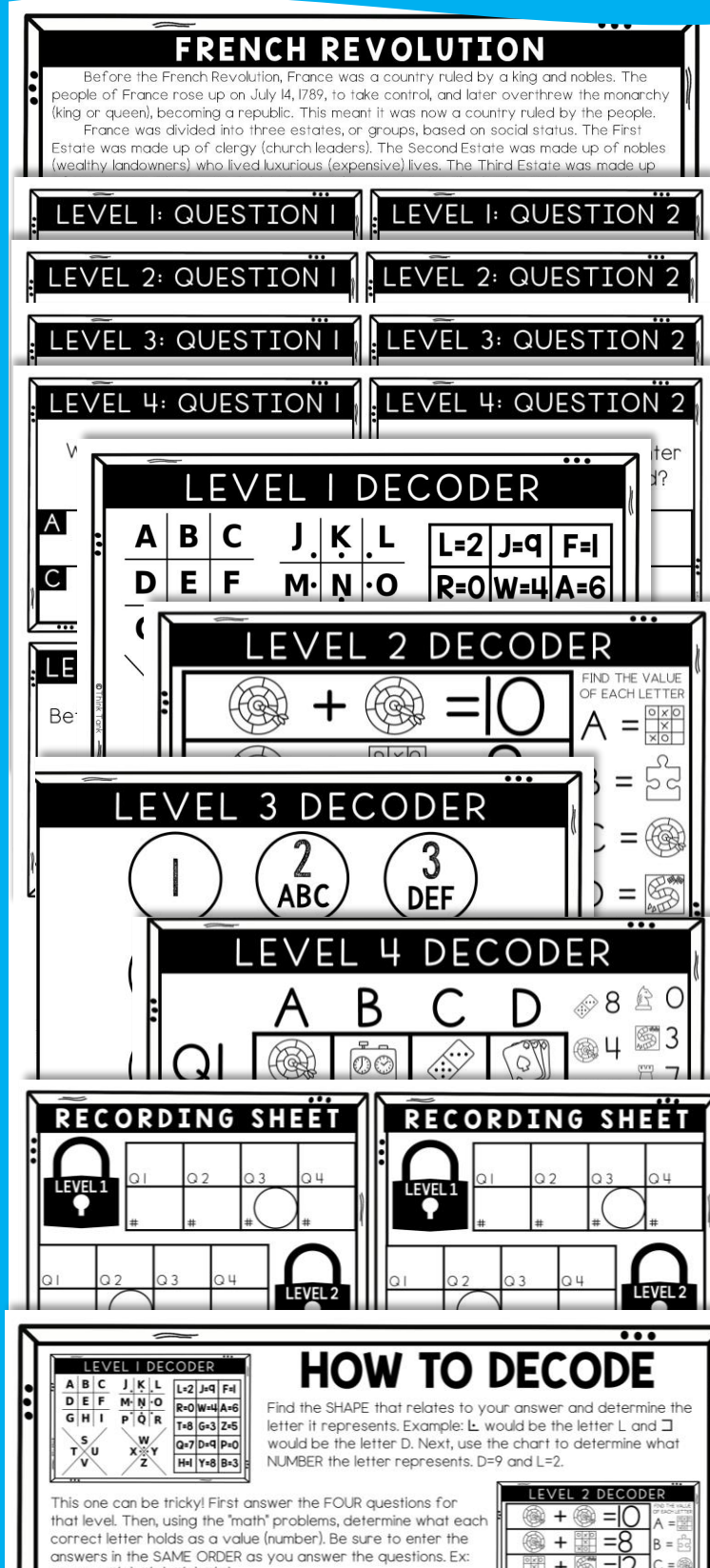

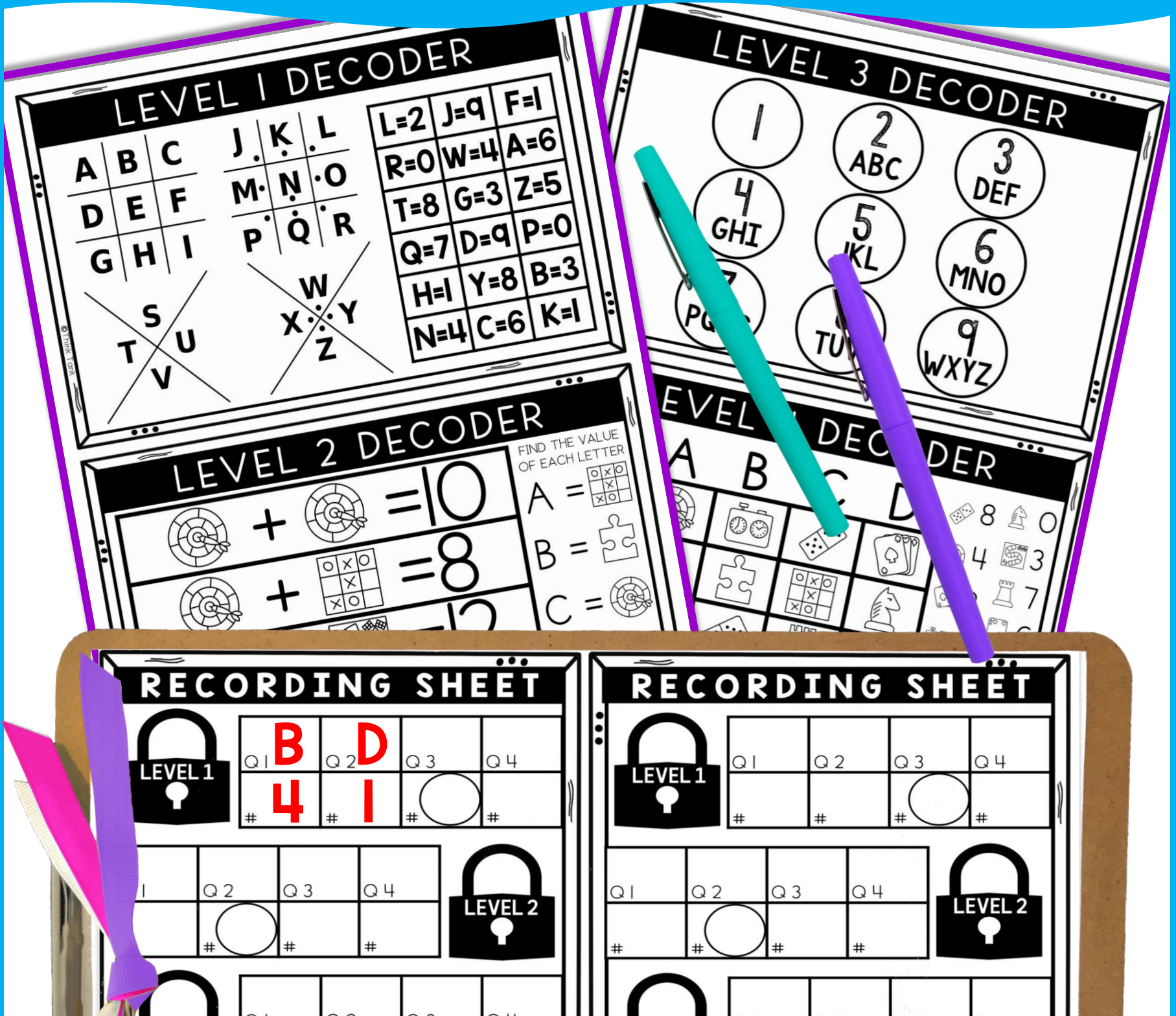

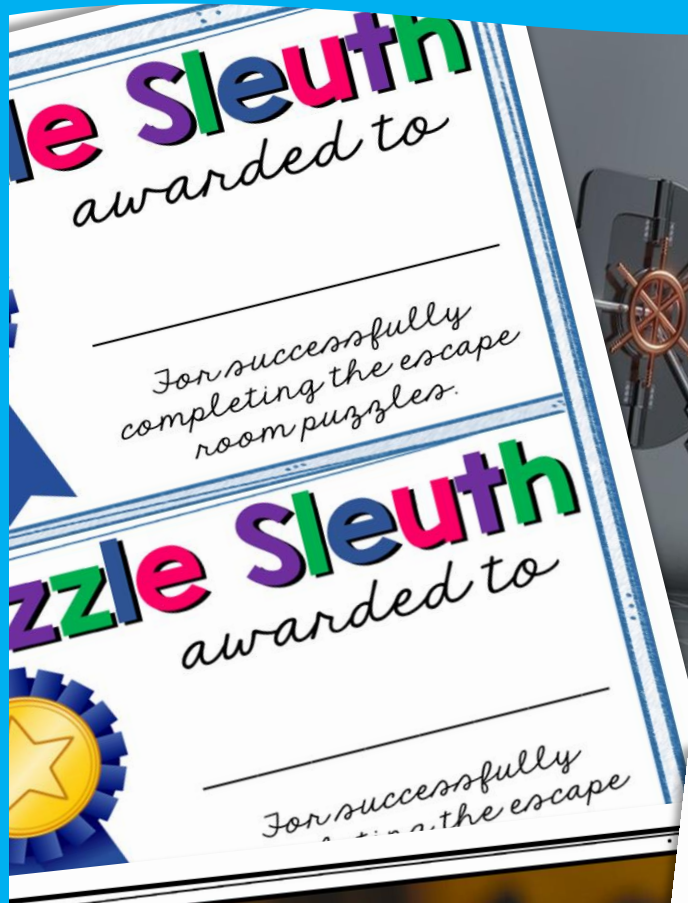

### FRENCH REVOL

Before the French Revolution, France was a country where the people of France rose up on July 14, 1789, to take control, (king or queen), becoming a republic. This meant it was no longer a monarchy. France was divided into three estates, or groups, based on social class. The First Estate was made up of clergy (church leaders). The Second Estate was made up of wealthy landowners (expensive) lived in luxury. The Third Estate of commoners. They were the hardest working group who paid the taxes.

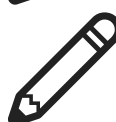
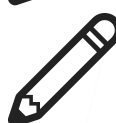
