

On December 16, 1773, the Sons of Liberty decided to take action against British laws on taxation. Disguised as Native Americans, members of the Sons of Liberty stormed aboard the British ships sitting in the harbor. Once onboard the ships, they dumped three chests of tea overboard in the harbor. No one was hurt, and the participants reportedly cleaned the ships' decks before they left. They destroyed over 92,000 pounds of tea. Today, that amount of tea would be worth close to one million dollars. The Boston Tea Party was a protest by the American Colonists in regards to the tea tax that the British had imposed on them.




