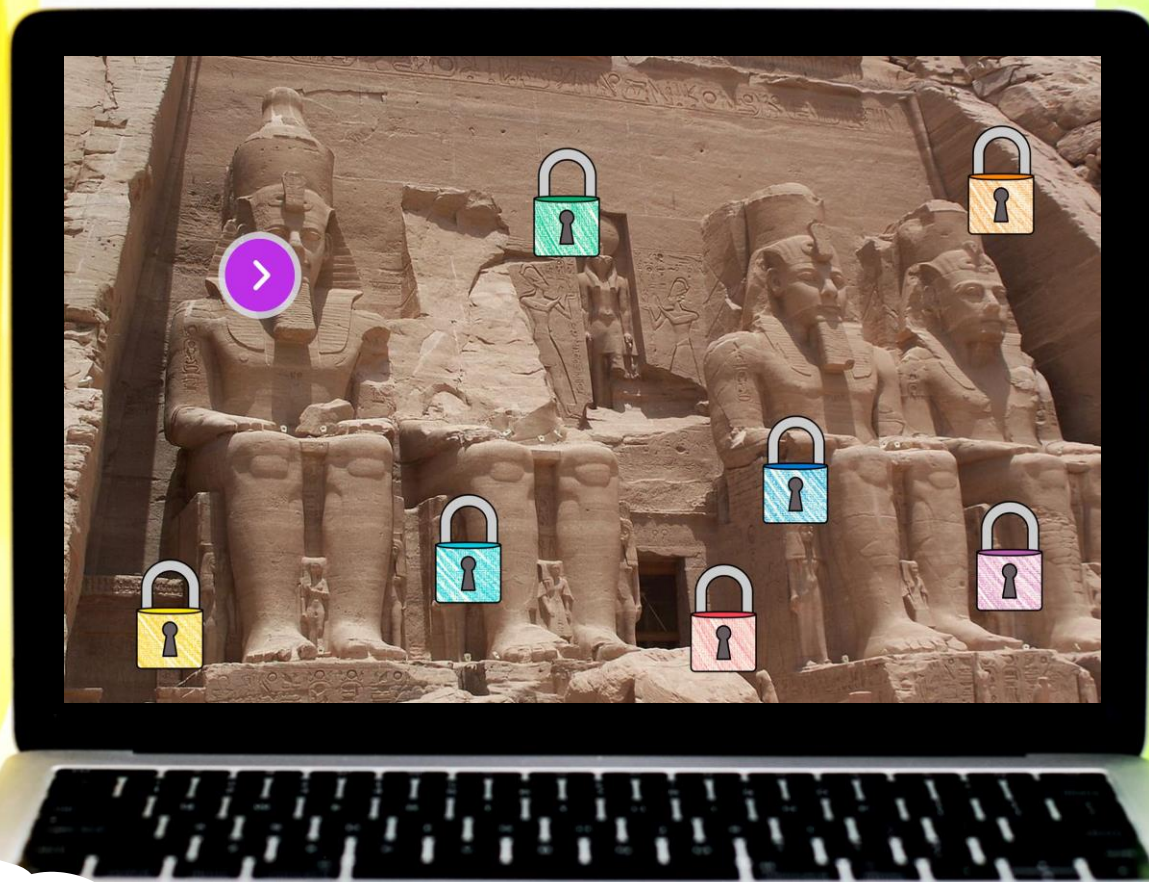

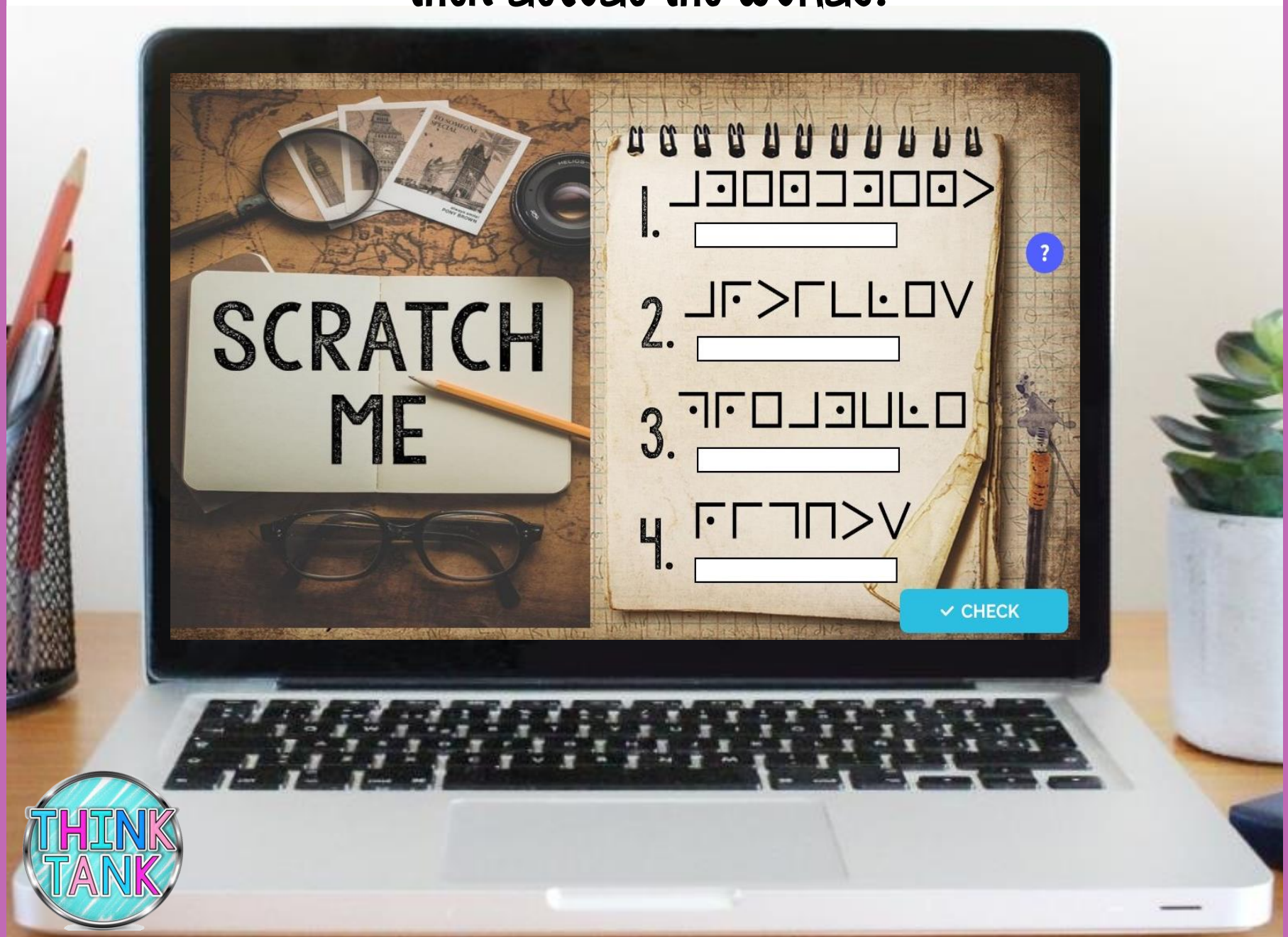




The Eighteenth Dynasty included Hatshepsut, Akhenaten, Thutmose III, and Tutankhamun. Hatshepsut ruled longer than any other woman of Egypt. Reigning for 22 years, she established trade networks, increased wealth, and maintained peace. King Tut, or Tutankhamun, only served as king for ten years. He became king at age 9 and died when he was 19 years old. Tut is most famous for his intact tomb filled with treasures. Howard Carter discovered the tomb in 1922 on an expedition in Egypt. Amenhotep III ruled for 39 years and was very well known because of the wealth, power, and peace he brought to Egypt. Egypt was at its best during his time as pharaoh. Thutmose III ruled for 54 years and greatly expanded the Egyptian empire. His military skills were put to test at the Battle of Megiddo, where he led a surprise attack which resulted in victory.
