

Over the decades, the Statue of Liberty his a welcom for millions of immigrants as they arrived in America. Lady Libe over 300 feet tall and made of green copper patina. The statue originally brown and took over 30 years to turn green. The green formed on the surface due to exposure to the weather.

Lady Liberty was sent from France on a French ship called the "Isere." She was broken down into 350 individual pieces and packed in to 214 crates. It took four months for workers to reassemble the statue once it reached New York. She was mounted on the pedestal which was created in America as a joint effort.

The United States did some fundraising to pay for the pedestal. Joseph Pulitzer used his New York newspaper to raise money. The Statue of Liberty is the tallest metal statue ever made.

Emma Lazarus wrote a poem called "The New Colossus" for an author to raise money for the expensive pedestal. The poem was about welcoming immigrants from other countries. In 1903, a bronze plaque with her poem was inscribed on the monument in her honor.

The Statue of Liberty has many hidden meanings. There are broken chains near her feet. Those chains symbolize the struggle for freedom. They symbolize the United State breaking free from tyranny or harsh rulers.

The torch she is holding in her right hand represents liberty and enlightenment. It also symbolizes the way to freedom or the path to Liberty. Her crown has seven spikes. They represent the seven seas and seven continents of the world.


