


Government and religion were connected in Ancient Egypt and the pharaoh was the head of both. The pharaoh was like a king and was the most powerful person in Ancient Egypt, thought to be connected to the gods. The vizier worked under the pharaoh and ampleted most of the government's daily

Pharaoh Djoser ruled during the Third Dynasty. He divided Egypt into different nomes (similar to states) with a governor for each, known as a nomarch. The nomarchs would check in with the pharaoh about what was happening in their nome. The Fourth Dynasty was considered to be the peak of the Old Kingdom, with powerful pharaohs such as Sneferu and Khufu.




