

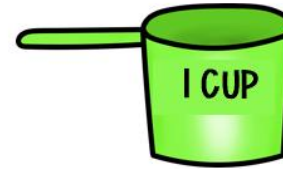
CAKE MIX

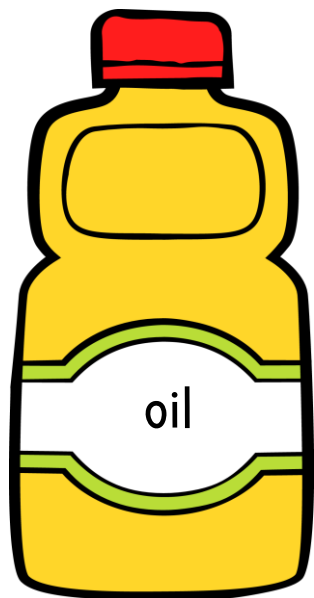

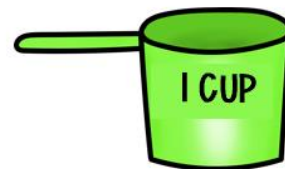
The ingredients include a drink but it's not coffee and is not pink.

Lilies are a flower often associated with Easter and represent grace and purity. Easter lilies are native to a few islands in southern Japan. They were first brought to England in 1827. After Japan, the white flowers were brought to Bermuda, but a virus wiped them out and Japan was once again the only

place to find Easter lilies. After World War I, a soldier brought a suitcase of lily bulbs back from Japan to Oregon and they have been there ever since.

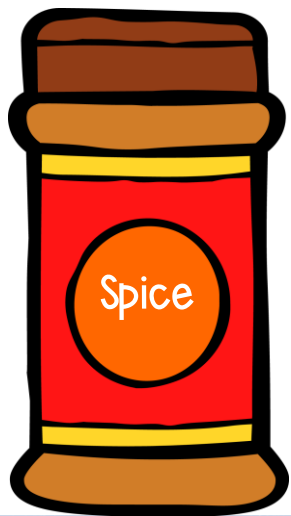

In 1991, Australia began to replace the Easter bunny with the Easter bilby. A bilby is a rabbit-eared bandicoot. They did this because rabbits commonly destroyed their crops and food. The bilby lives in deserts, forests, grasslands, and dry shrubby areas.

They are nocturnal animals which live in underground dens that are around

five feet long. Australia sells chocolate bilbies at Easter time and the money raised from the sales is used to fund protection for the bilby.

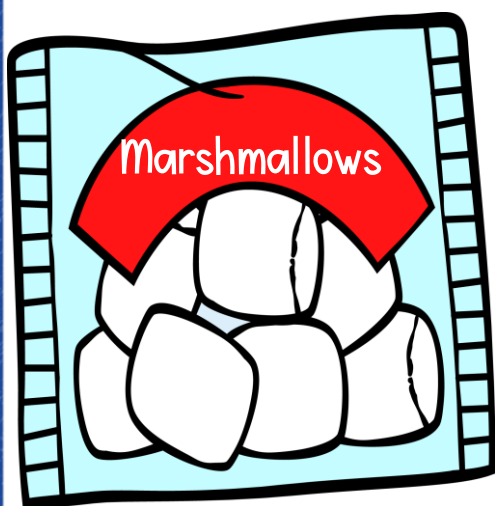

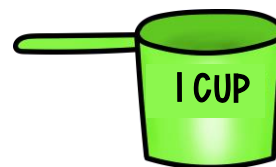
MARSHMALLOW

The record egg stood 34 feet tall and weighed more than an elephant at 17,733 pounds! The largest decorated Easter egg was built in Portugal and measured 48 feet long and 27 feet wide. 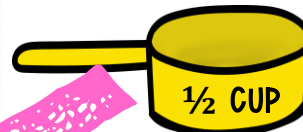
the largest decorated Easter egg tree was set in Germany with 76,596 painted hen eggs.
