




# JIGSAW PUZZLE

Before the war began, Europe was building up in military power. Countries were competing to gain land and power. The war was divided into two alliances—the Central Powers and the Allied Powers. Members of the Allied Powers were France, Great Britain and the United States. They were also known as the Entente Powers. After 1917, the United States joined the Allied Powers. Members of the Central Powers were Germany, Austria-Hungary, the Ottoman Empire (Turkey) and Bulgaria.




