After colonists started boycotting tea,
Britain lost a substantial amount of money on
tea that was never bought. In response,
Parliament passed the Tea Act, which allowed
Britain to have a monopoly (to have full control)
on tea. This meant the colonists could not buy
tea from any other country or place and had
to pay the high tax on tea to Britain.


