

To honor Earth Day in Panama, one hundred types of orchids were planted to prevent their extinction. Around the world, an estimated fifteen billion trees are cut down each year. Trees release oxygen and absorb CO2 (carbon dioxide). Twenty percent of the Earth's oxygen is produced by the Amazon Rainforest.

When we increase carbon dioxide levels in the atmosphere, global temperatures rise. The rise of temperature intensifies the greenhouse effect. The greenhouse effect is when heat in the atmosphere is trapped by greenhouse gases such as carbon dioxide, methane and nitrous oxide.


