

North America includes many countries occupying the same large mass of land as well as Central America and some Caribbean islands. The continent is home to 23 countries. The four largest countries in North America are Canada, the United States, Greenland, and Mexico. North America is bordered by the Atlantic Ocean to the east and the Pacific Ocean to the west. The smallest North American country is St Kitts and Nevis with only about 54,000 inhabitants.

Canada is the largest country by size covering 3.8 million square miles with a population of around 38.4 million people. It is the second largest country in the world. Much of Canada is tundra making it too cold for people to inhabit, so most Canadians live near the southern border they share with the United States. Canada has the world's longest coastline. Canadians mostly speak English and French.

The United States is the second largest country by size covering 3.79 million square miles. The United States has the largest population in North America, with over 335 million people. The U.S. city with the largest population is New York City. Most Americans speak English, but there are many different languages spoken by the many different people groups that live in the United States home.

Greenland is the third largest country by size in the North America continent, with over 836,000 square miles. Greenland is so far north that not a lot of people live there. The population of around 57,000. The capital city, Nuuk, is located in southwestern Greenland. It has a population of just over 8,000 people. Many of the people who live in Greenland are Inuit.
