




JIGSAW PUZZLE

The Judicial Branch is Article III of the United States Constitution. The main job of the Judicial Branch is to interpret the laws. The Judicial Branch is the federal court system which includes the U.S. Supreme Court, U.S. District Courts and U.S. Appeals Courts. The Judicial Branch is made up of judges and their courts. Federal judges are not elected by the people. The president appoints, or chooses, the justices and then they are confirmed, or approved, by the Senate. The Supreme Court is the highest court in the United States. The Supreme Court is made up of nine justices. One Chief Justice and eight Associate Justices. A justice serves a life term. A life term allows the justices to make good decisions and not feel the pressure to please the public if elected.


