


The people also wanted strong guarantees that the new government would not be too powerful. The Founding Fathers and the people all wanted a government that was limited, but correctly limited. Several states signed the Constitution with the understanding that a Bill of Rights would be added promptly. On September 17, 1787, 39 delegates signed the Constitution, however, three of the delegates refused to sign the Constitution without a Bill of Rights.


