



FIRST AMENDMENT

DID YOU KNOW?

The government can say where and when people assemble, but cannot ban the assembly.

The U.S. Constitution has 27 amendments. The first ten amendments are known as the Bill of Rights. The Bill of Rights was ratified (approved) in 1791. The first ten amendments of the U.S. Constitution outline the rights and freedoms of all Americans. It put limits on what the government could do and control.

AMENDMENT 1: The First Amendment is made up of five parts. Those parts include freedoms of religion, assembly, press, petition and speech. Freedom of Religion allows Americans to believe and practice whatever religion they choose. Federal and state governments are not allowed to establish an official religion (Establishment Clause). The government may not favor one religion or treat people differently because of their religious beliefs.

Freedom of the Press allows Americans to publish their opinions and the government cannot punish them. Press includes newspapers, internet, TV, radio, etc.

Freedom of Petition means that you can request change from your government.

The Freedom of Assembly is the right to gather together in groups for any reason as long as they are peaceful.

The Freedom of Speech allows individuals to say what is on their mind. There are limitations such as shouting in a crowded movie theatre. Founding Fathers did not want their new government

AMENDMENT 5: The Fifth Amendment protects citizens from being tried without due process of law. This means it guarantees people the right to a fair and legal trial. The Fifth Amendment allows citizens the right to remain silent. If a person is arrested, the police must read them their rights. **You do not have to testify against yourself (self-incrimination).** The Fifth Amendment also prevents citizens from being tried for the same crime twice (Double Jeopardy). A grand jury decides if there is enough evidence to say if a person should be charged with a crime. If so, the judge will issue an indictment which means a person is officially charged with a crime. The Fifth Amendment also covers eminent domain. The government can take your private land for public use, but it must pay a fair amount.

AMENDMENT 6: The Sixth Amendment guarantees the right to a fair and speedy trial with a jury of one's peers. Impartial means a fair and unbiased jury with randomly selected jurors. If you are accused of a crime with the right to a lawyer, even if they can not afford one, **they cannot afford one, the government in the state in which they live will pay for the lawyer.** These lawyers are called public defenders.

AMENDMENT 7: The Seventh Amendment guarantees the right to a trial with a jury. A civil trial settles a legal dispute between two or more parties. A jury in a civil case is made up of people who hear the non-criminal cases. In civil cases, the person suing for damage is called the "plaintiff."
