# READING #1

The original Thirteen Colonies were started by a country called England. The colonies were created in America during the 1600 and 1700s. A colony is an area of land under the control of another country. The 13 colonies were divided into three regions: New England, Middle Colonies, and Southern Colonies.

Some settlers came from Scotland, Ireland, Wales, Germany and other parts of Europe.

The 13 colonies were located along the Atlantic coast in the United States.

People came to the colonies for different reasons. Many came for land and jobs. Some settlers came in search of religious freedom. They were being treated bad for their religious beliefs and wanted a place where they could worship as they pleased. Ultimately, they were searching for a better life.

The first colony in America was called Jamestown. It was created in 1607.

# READING #2

The New England colonies included New Hampshire, Connecticut, Massachusetts Bay, and Rhode Island.

The cold weather, rocky land, and mountains made it difficult to farm. Usually, the soil of New England was only enough food to feed the family. They could not grow extra food to sell to other colonists. Many colonists traded furs and went fishing to make money.

Most of the people in the New England colonies focused on family and religion. In New England, not everyone could practice their religion in the way that they wanted. Some people came to America because they wanted to worship in their own way with religious freedom.

When the colonists first arrived, they found many forests in the region. They cut down trees to build ships, houses, and buildings.
