Justices serve in the Supreme Court until retirement, impeachment, or death. Impeachment is when a highranking government official is accused of misconduct while in office. There is no term limit for this position, like there are in other government positions. A life term allows Justices to not worry about 'popularity' and therefore base their court decisions on the law, not

 The Supreme Court is different because there is not a jury. After the Justices have heard the case, they will deliberate and give an opinion on the case. A majority opinion reflects the views of more than fifty percent of the Justices. When a Justice disagrees with the decision of the majority, a dissenting opinion is given.






