The Level I Tarsia puzzles are already filled in for the students.

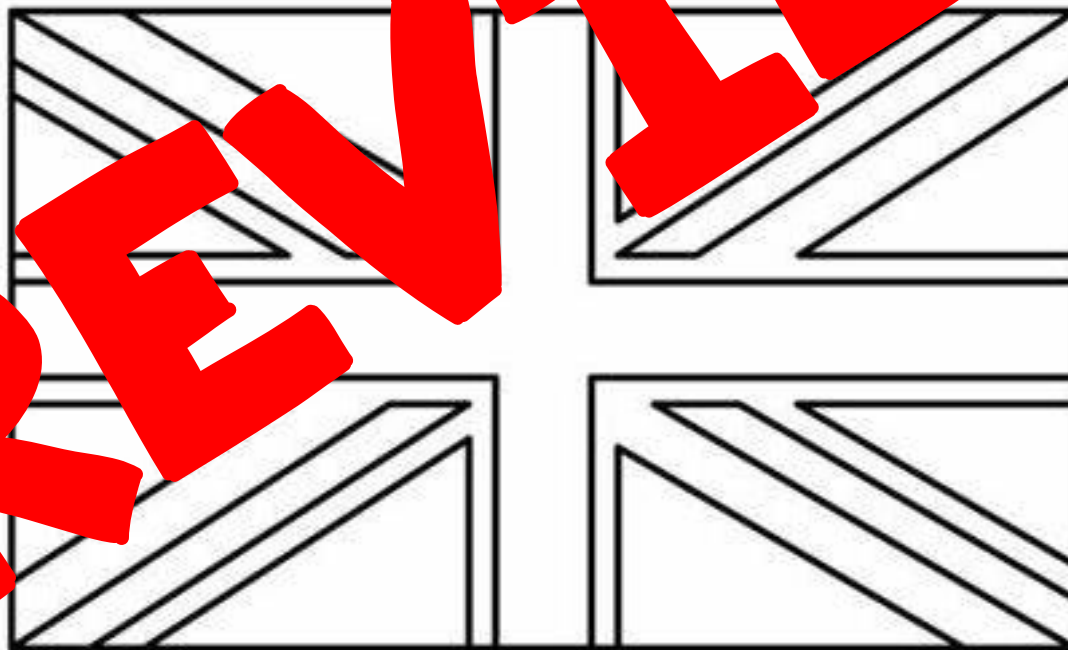
Students will work in groups to match the event to the event descriptions. They will then tape the pieces together.

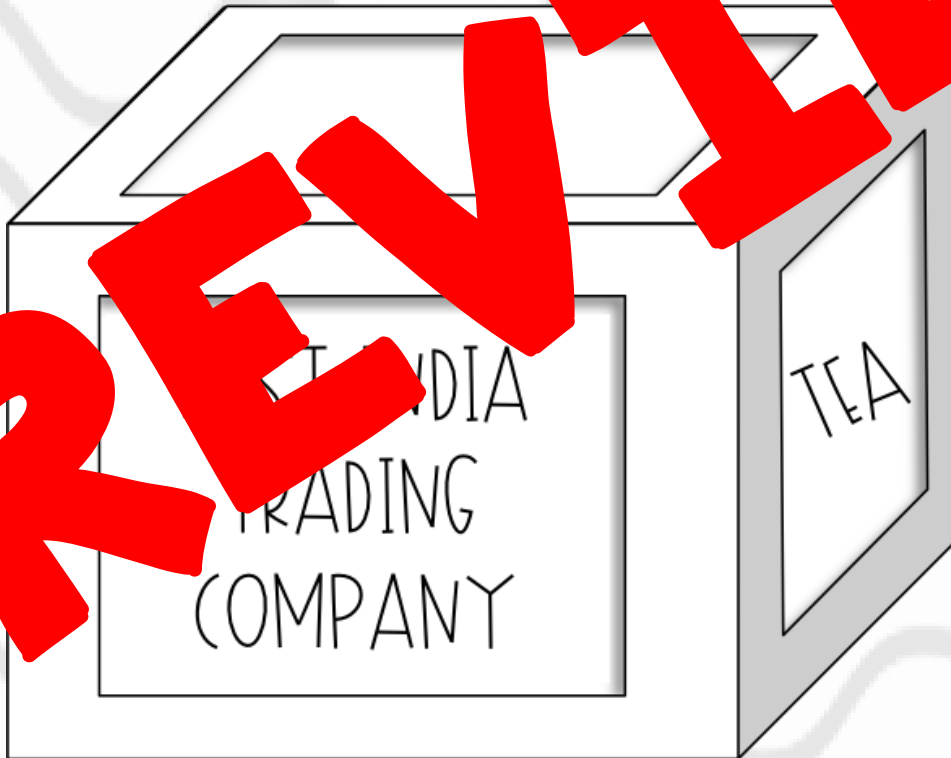

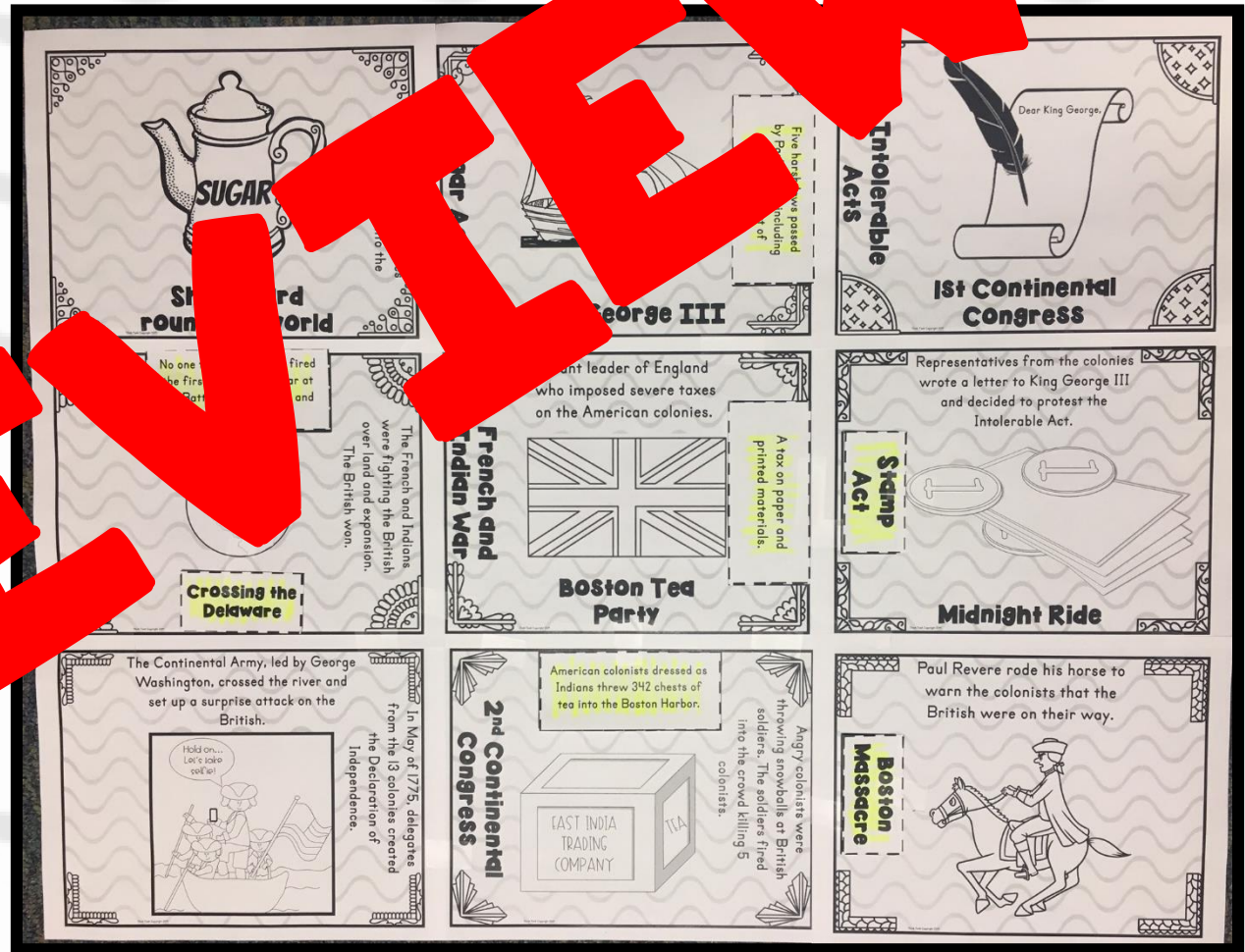

LEVEL #2 - PARTIALLY FILLED IN TARSIA

If the description is given, students will determine the title of the event and vice versa. Students will cut out the puzzle pieces, paste the correct titles/descriptions on the labeled spaces.
