

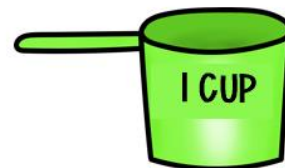
# BAKING SODA

Over the past 230 years, more than 11,000 amendments, or changes, have been introduced in Congress. As of 2020, twenty-seven of those have received the necessary approval from the states to become an amendment. The first ten amendments are called the Bill of Rights. Those ten amendments guarantee that U.S.

citizens have their rights protected. The Bill of Rights was ratified, or approved, in 1791.

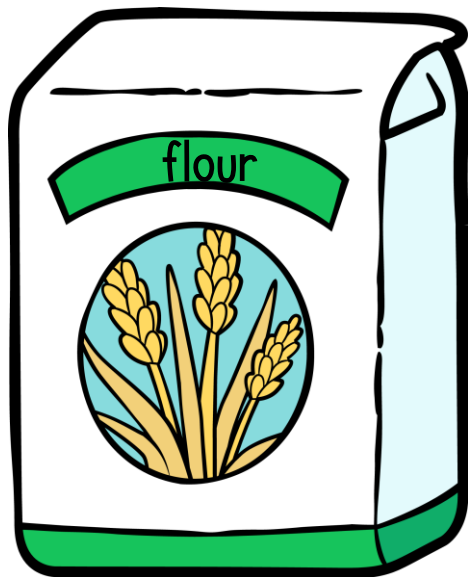

Some of the original Framers (writers) were troubled at the idea that the original Constitution lacked a description of individual rights for the people. People known as Federalists (because they supported the federal government) were in favor of the Constitution. Federalists felt that a bill of rights was not necessary because the Constitution

intentionally limited the powers of the federal government. Alexander Hamilton, James Madison and John Jay played leading Federalist roles.

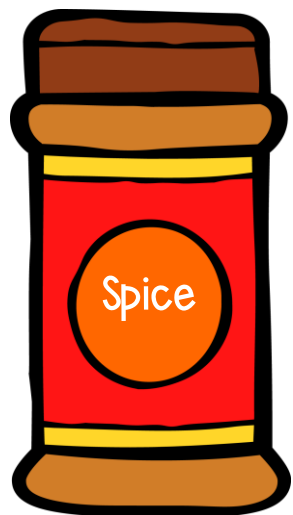

# SPICE

The Constitution has seven Articles (or sections) that detail the layout of the United States government. The first three articles define the powers of the three branches of government.

The three branches are the Legislative, Executive and Judicial Branch. The Constitution made sure that no one branch of the government could have too much power. This is called "Checks and Balances." Other Articles include states' rights and the amendment process.

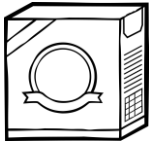
