# READING #1

Paul Revere was born in 1734 in Boston, Massachusetts. In 1754, he was forced to take over the family business. In the shop, he engraved metal and sold silverware and tea sets. During tough times, Revere would clean teeth. He was taught by his surgeon friend, Doctor Joseph Warren. Paul was an excellent horse rider and carried messages between Boston, New York, and Philadelphia.

In 1765 the Stamp Act was passed. The British Parliament began taxing the colonies to help pay for the debt from the French and Indian War. The Stamp Act taxed all paper documents in the colonies such as newspapers. The colonists insisted that the act was unfair since there was no one in the British government to represent them.

Paul Revere became an active member of the Sons of Liberty. The Sons of Liberty was a group of American Patriots who wanted freedom for the colonies, to fight unfair taxes and to protect the rights of colonists.

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# READING #2

Tensions grew between the British troops and the townspeople of Boston when snowballs, sticks and rocks were thrown at British soldiers. In March of 1770, the British army fired into a crowd of American protesters, killing five. This event is known as the Boston Massacre.

Paul Revere created an engraving of the event that placed the blame on the British soldiers. His engraving showed an angry group of British soldiers firing into a crowd of innocent American colonists. His copper engraving made Americans even more upset with the British and added to their need for independence.

The Boston Tea Party occurred in 1773. To protest the tax on tea, Paul Revere and other Sons of Liberty boarded three British trade ships in the Boston Harbor. They disguised themselves as Mohawk Indians and threw 342 chests of tea into the water. Paul Revere was the leader of the Boston Tea Party.

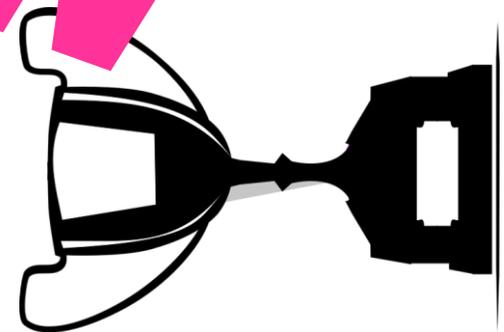

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

