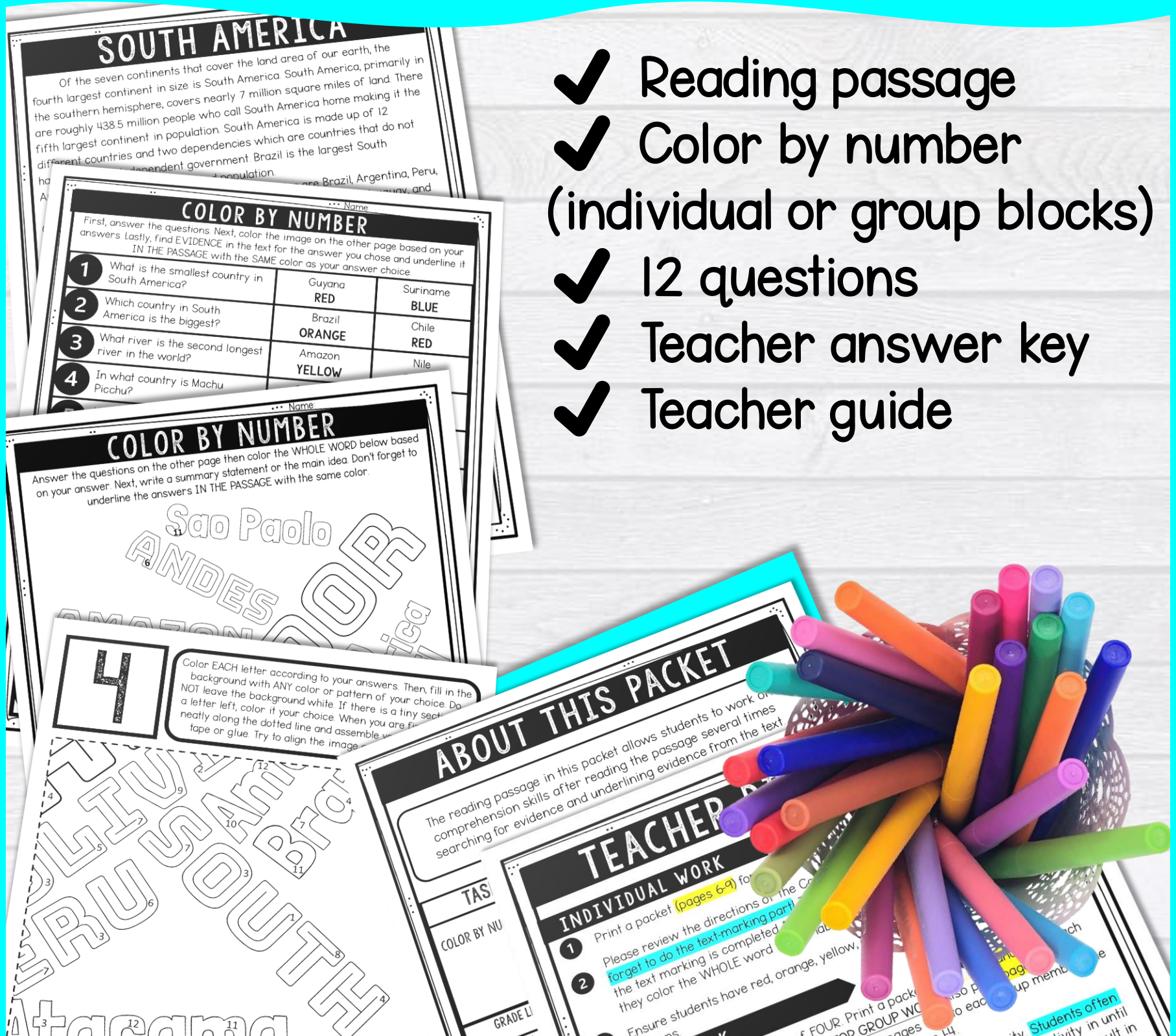

South America is made up of 12 different countries and two dependencies which are countries that do not have their own independent government. Brazil is the largest South American country in both size and population.

The 12 countries that make up South America are Brazil, Argentina, Peru, Colombia, Bolivia, Venezuela, Chile, Paraguay, Ecuador, Guyana, Uruguay, and Suriname. The three dependent countries are French Guiana which is ruled by France, the Falkland Islands, which is claimed by both Britain and Argentina, and South Sandwich and North Georgia Islands, which are claimed by the British.

The Incan Civilization was a dominant force in South America before Spain and Portugal colonized most of the continent. In the 15th century, conquerors and European settlers came to South America, so many people still speak Spanish, Portuguese, French, and English. Native populations have lived in South America since at least 10,000 BC and many unique languages and cultural aspects still used today. There are more than one hundred languages used in Brazil. Quechua is still spoken in Peru. In Suriname, formerly a Dutch colony, the other language spoken is Dutch. Brazil is the largest country in South America and has the largest population because Portuguese sailors and settlers came to Brazil in the late 1400s. Brazil has nearly 216 million people. Brazil is only slightly smaller than the United States and has nearly 216 million people. Brazil is also home to the largest city in South America. The city of Sao Paulo is home to over 22 million people currently.
