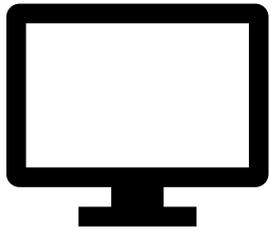

**GREAT WALL OF CHINA**

The Great Wall of China covers most of the northern border of China. It is a series of walls running in an east-west line. The Great Wall began to be built by the Qin Dynasty.

Originally the Great Wall was a series of several walls that joined together. The first set of walls were built in the 7th century BC. The Great Wall was built to keep out northern Mongol and Russian invaders. Qin Shi Huang, China's first Emperor wanted a single giant wall to protect his northern borders. He was also known as King Zheng of Qin.

Qin Shi Huang ordered a wall to be built with lookout towers where soldiers could protect his empire from the Xiongnu, nomads from Mongolia. The wall includes watch towers, barracks and areas where smoke signals could be sent to warn of an invasion.

The Great Wall of China was commonly referred to as the longest cemetery on earth. Historians believe more than one million people died during its construction. It is the longest man-built structure in the world.

The construction of the Great Wall was completed in a time span of 1,800 years. The Great Wall as it is today is almost completely the work of the Ming Dynasty from 1368 to 1644 CE. There is very little of the original wall left today.

Mongol invaders were able to get through parts of the wall that were not complete. Mongols were eventually able to conquer most of northern China. Genghis Khan was the leader of the Mongol invaders. The Ming dynasty defeated the Mongolians in 1368.

The Great Wall was made from stone, wood, bricks, tiles and limestone. Oddly, it was also built with glutinous rice also known as "sticky rice". The sticky rice contributed to the wall's strength.

The wheelbarrow, invented by the Chinese, was used during the construction of the wall. The wall was built by peasants, criminals,


