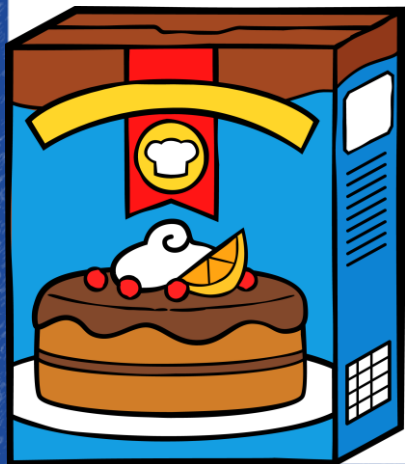
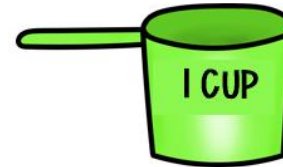


# CAKE MIX

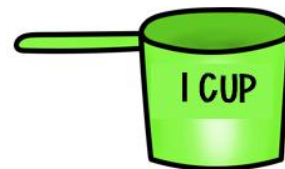
# BAKING SODA

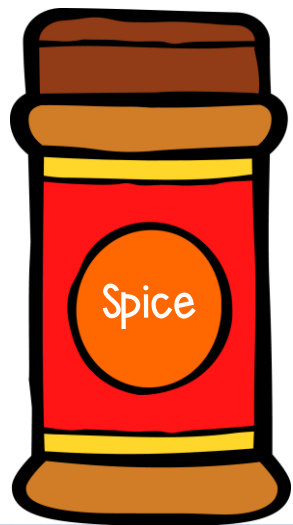

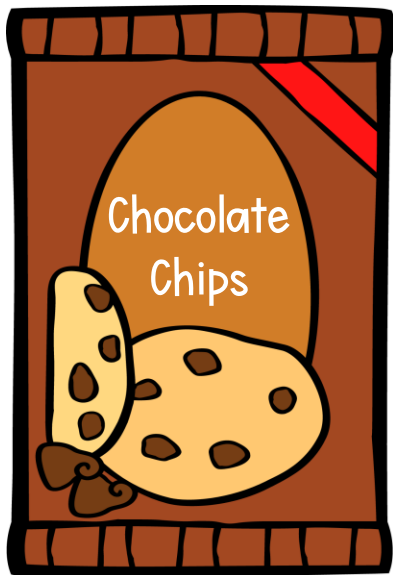

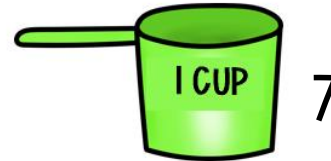
# CHOCOLATE CHIPS
