Did you know?

Cook collected and recorded numerous plants and animals throughout his numerous expeditions.

- Captain James Cook was born in England on October 27, 1728. His father was a farmer, but James was more interested in the open waters. As a teenager, he took an apprenticeship to become trained as a merchant seaman. He worked on ships that were meant for trading goods.
- Although he enjoyed his work, Cook decided to enlist in the Royal Navy during the Seven Years War. After just two years, he was promoted to his ship's master. His ability to navigate ships and make accurate maps was noticed by high ranking officers in the Navy.
- In 1768, England's Royal Society appointed him to lead an exploration to the Pacific Ocean. Cook was given command of a vessel called the Endeavour.
- Cook was known as a strict captain. He believed his crew members needed to be healthy for the expedition to be successful. He made his crew bathe on a daily basis. He also made them change out their bed sheets and towels twice a week. He ordered his crew to eat fruit to avoid scurvy. Scurvy was a disease caused by lack of Vitamin C.

Did you know?

Benjamin Franklin asked American warships to track Cook's ships.

- The goal of this first expedition was to observe and track Venus as it passed between the Earth and the Sun. He was asked to find a transit of Venus across the Sun. This information would help astronomers calculate the distance between the Sun and the Earth. Cook also wanted to discover a southern continent that was rumored to exist. This mythical continent was called Terra Australis.
- During the first voyage, Captain James Cook discovered Tahiti, New Zealand and the Society Islands. Cook ended up fighting with the local Maori tribe in New Zealand while mapping out the coastline. The Maori tribe did not allow or like foreign visitors. Cook managed to map the coastline of New Zealand and discovered the Cook Strait.
- After New Zealand, Captain James Cook and his crew sailed to the east coast of Australia. Australia was at the time known as New Holland. His ship was damaged by coral from the Great Barrier Reef. They were forced to stay in Australia until the ship was being repaired.






