

Bloodthirsty Bats?

There might be a good reason why Bruce Wayne aka Batman picked the bat as his superhero symbol! Bats are mammals that live all over the world except in extreme cold like the Artic. Bats are the only mammals that can fly! They love to roost in caves, old buildings, trees, and under bridges. Bats rest during the day and are active at night which means they are nocturnal. Many bats use echolocation which means that they use echo sounds to find their food. Do you know any other animals that use echolocation?

With more than 1,100 species in the world, bats are hard to miss! That means that bats' population equals 20 percent of all mammals on earth! Bats fall into two different groups: megabats and microbats. Megabats eat fruit or nectar and do not use echolocation like other bats. Microbats eat insects, and some even eat fish or drink blood! So, do you think Batman chose the right symbol? Or are bats just mean, blood-thirsty creatures!?
