



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"GO-FISH" GAMES RULES Place all the cards facedown. Start with the player who is the youngest. Each player will turn over the cards two at a time to try and find words that match. When you find a match, you DO NOT immediately get to go again. The next player will try to find a match. The game keeps going until there are no cards left. The player with the most matches wins.

PARTNER GAMES RULES




The player who is the oldest deals the cards first. Each player gets 7 cards.

- Place the rest of the cards in a pile face down. See if you have any matches already in your hand and place those down in front of you.
- Then each player pulls one card at a time from the deck and places it down for both players to see. The player who has a match can claim that card. If no one has a match, the player who pulled the card keeps it.
- Continue to take turns pulling a card until the middle pile is empty. The person with the most matches wins.
