OPTION 2:


Leave each shamrock in one whole piece so that students see the base word, spelling rule, and example sentence together.

As a Google Forms quiz or Google Forms practice activity. This resource has 2 quizzes with 20 questions in each one.




SPELLING RULES COVERED


Here are the spelling rules included in this resource:

- Adding "es" to words that end with —ch, -sh, -s, -x, or —z
 (ex. buses)
 - Dropping the "y" and adding an "i," then "es" to words that have a consonant before the y. (ex. babies)
 - Keeping the "y" and adding "s" to words that have a
 vowel before the y. (ex. monkeys)
 - Dropping the "f" at the end of words to add "ves" (ex. elves)

More Helpful Things to Know:

- Verbs and nouns are included
- Extra blank shamrocks are included for students to write their own spelling words on them for extended practice.
- An Editable Template is included for you to type spelling words for your students for additional practice.











