


BEETHOVEN'S SYMPHONIES

Beethoven's 7th Symphony had four movements. It premiered in Vienna at a charity concert for wounded soldiers from the Battle of Hanau. After hearing it for the first time, the audience demanded an encore (a repeat performance) of the second movement, *Allegretto*. Beethoven had already discovered he was going deaf when he composed his 7th Symphony. By the time he wrote his ninth and final symphony, he was completely deaf.

CONGA VERSUS DJEMBE

Congas originated from Cuba. These drums were originally played in Cuban music ensembles, called comparsas, which included singers and dancers.

Djembes originated from West Africa. The Djembe got its name from a Mali saying, which translates as, "everyone gather together in peace".










